Math Professor Job Description

The mission of Catholic Distance University is to communicate the mind and heart of the Church in a digital world.

Position summary:

To teach a bachelor's level course exploring mathematics for the liberal arts, designed to enable students to more fully appreciate the truth of Galileo's claim that "Mathematics is the alphabet by which God has written the universe" and establish math's practical relevance to everyday living.

Teaching Responsibilities:

1. Initiate a weekly asynchronous discussion by 9 am EST each Monday during the academic term.
2. Post grades for weekly discussions by 9 am EST of the following Tuesday.
3. Respond within 48 hours to all student inquiries regarding coursework.
4. Conduct, monitor, and evaluate online interaction and discussion and supervise the online classroom.
5. Attend the CDU faculty webinar.
6. Post office hours and contact information in the course syllabus and "instructor information" section of Canvas, and hold a minimum of one office hour per week (ideally a live, interactive hour for students).
7. Complete course evaluation and maintain the Course Hour Worksheet as needed.
8. Enter final grades in the student record system.
9. At least two weeks before a given course is scheduled to open:
 - a. Perform quality assurance on the latest iteration of the course to ensure that hyperlinks are in order, the syllabus and assignments are up to date, and quiz questions and final exams are clear and contain no errors.

- b. Update due dates and confirming parameters in Canvas for all assignments, including discussions, quizzes, term papers and proposals, etc.
- c. Update courses as needed so that they fully reflect current knowledge and the *status questionis* in the subject matter, take full advantage of available technologies to maximize day-to-day faculty presence, and best achieve learning outcomes.

Qualifications and Requirements:

1. **Education:** Ideally have a terminal degree in Mathematics from an accredited institution.
2. **Experience:**
 - a. Teaching experience is required
 - b. online teaching experience is strongly preferred
3. **Candidate must be a practicing Catholic** in good standing with both knowledge of and fidelity to the teachings of the Catholic Church, and with a commitment to supporting *Ex corde ecclesiae* and the New Evangelization in the context of CDU's mission.
4. Candidate must have a sincere commitment to student support and success.
