

AMS-Catholic Distance University Partnership

Catholic Distance University (<u>CDU</u>) offers 60 independent study courses (mostly in English, with an increasing number of courses in Spanish) along with a few seminar-style facilitated courses (English only). The courses and seminars are excellent for adult faith formation and for meeting the AMS catechist certification requirement.

The following is a correlation of the courses/seminars to the 14 standards of Forming Disciples for the New Evangelization: Archdiocesan Religion Curriculum Guide. The correlation helps adults and catechists discern the course that will meet their faith formation needs to proclaim Christ as missionary disciple in the spirit of the New Evangelization.

Coordinators of Religious Education (CRE) who do not hold a Master's degree in Theology or a related field are encouraged to pursue the <u>Basic Certificate in Catechesis</u>.

Use the access code **CDU15MILITARY** when you create your account/profile to apply the partnership subsidized price of **\$45 for independent study courses** and **\$65 for online seminars**, marked at the regular registration fee of \$89 and \$99 respectively in the <u>Course Catalog</u> You can take either one course or one seminar to meet the AMS requirements through CDU.

On-line seminars explore various topics in the field of Apologetics. Some of these seminars correlate with the Archdiocesan Curriculum Guide.
